DAY 1 SATURDAY JUNE 21ST, 2025 TRAVEL DAY TO ESCANABA, MICHIGAN

This morning we will depart southwestern Wisconsin and travel to the southwest part of the upper peninsula of Michigan to the Escanaba area for our first overnight stay.

DAY 2 SUNDAY JUNE 22ND, 2025 MACKINAC ISLAND

This morning we will depart the Escanaba area and travel along the Upper Peninsula of Michigan to St. Ignace. This afternoon we will be boarding the ferry to Mackinac Island, which we will be calling home for the next two evenings. This charming island is three miles long, two miles wide, and transportation on the island is limited to carriage, bike, horse, or foot!! The island is home to about 500 year—round residents. The magnificent Victorian architecture recalls a time of days gone. This afternoon and evening you will have free time on your own to browse the different shops and sample some Mackinac Island fudge. **B**

DAY 3 MONDAY JUNE 23RD, 2025 EXPLORE MACKINAC ISLAND

This morning after your breakfast buffet at the hotel, you will be able to enjoy a carriage tour. You will tour the island aboard horse-drawn carriages. Observe the Governor's Mansion, a 24 room mansion that sits on a bluff overlooking the Straits of Mackinac. You'll also see Arch Rock, one of the most photographed spots on the island. This natural limestone formation has a span of 50 feet and rises 149 feet above the clear blue water of the straits. After our tour ends we will have an included lunch today. The remainder of the afternoon is free to relax, sightsee, and visit historic sites. **B,L**

DAY 4 TUESDAY JUNE 24TH, 2025 FRANKENMUTH, MICHIGAN

Begin the day with a tasty breakfast buffet before we depart the island and return to the mainland. This morning we will cross the magnificent five-mile long Mackinac Bridge, which links upper and lower Michigan. This afternoon we will arrive at the #1 visitor destination in Michigan – the German Village of Frankenmuth (Michigan's Little Bavaria). You will be able to enjoy everyone's favorite stop at Bronner's Christmas Wonderland. Now the size of 1 ½ football fields, Bronner's is the world's largest Christmas store. You will be able to shop for that special Christmas decoration or just enjoy the spectacle of hundreds of nativity scenes and other decorations, more than 200 decorated trees and the outdoor displays. Later this afternoon you will be able to enjoy a World Famous Frankenmuth Style Chicken Dinner served Family – Style. Chicken dinners are what put Frankenmuth on the map and have been served for over 100 years!!! . **B,D**

DAY 5 WEDNESDAY JUNE 25TH, 2025 BAVARIAN BELLE CRUISE

This morning after our breakfast at the hotel. This morning we will have a guided tour of the Frankenmuth area. Enjoy the city highlighting historical and community sites including a stop at St. Lorenz Lutheran church, where the city's history can be seen depicted in the stained glass windows. Later this morning we will have an one hour historical tour on the Bavarian Belle Riverboat stern paddlewheel vessel on the Cass River. Enjoy a narration from the Captain surrounding the history of Frankenmuth. After our cruise you will have some shopping time and have lunch on your own in the Frankenmuth area.
